Worship Special Projects

*When you do a worship service project, only do one project a Sunday as that is how it will be recorded. The only exception to this is if you are asked to do something from an adult. Please be mindful and respectful of your fellow confirmands and allow for everyone at the service to be able to complete a project. There should never be name calling or fighting over worship service projects. This is a service for your church. Remember whose house you are in and whose you are. Please remember to act like a Christian towards your fellow classmates.

- **Acolyting:** Light the candlelighter in the back of the sanctuary.
 - Light the right candle first by holding the candlelighter so that the taper is horizontal and touches the wick. Hold the taper on the wick until you see the candle is lit.
 - Blow out the flame. Place the candlelighter in its stand.
 - At the end of the service. Snuff the candles out. Place the candlelighter in its stand.
- **Turn on the sound system in the Sanctuary.** You can do this by pressing the red button in the back right corner of the Sanctuary. Be sure to do this 5-10 minutes before the worship service. Press start on the touch screen when it appears.
- **Turn off the sound system in the Sanctuary.** Press the red button on the top of the system.
- **Stream worship:** Grab the camera and phone in the back of the Sanctuary on the right side. There are instructions underneath the camera and iphone.
- **Volunteer to read lessons:** at church services by contacting the church office so you can get on the schedule to do so. The information for the church office is at the top right of this page.
- **Usher:** Hand out bulletins and be sure people sign in at the beginning of the worship service. Help Bart Moericke or whomever is the adult in the back of church helping with these duties. Assist with collecting the offering plates. If you have questions talk to Bart Moericke and he will help you.
- **Help a visiting Pastor serve communion.** If you notice it is a communion Sunday, assist the Pastor with serving communion. Talk to the Pastor before the service for instructions.
- **Help teach Sunday School.** Sunday School occurs everyone Sunday at 9:15a.m. in the basement. Talk to a Sunday School Teacher to see where you can help.
- If you help with something at the church for worship or during a worship service, talk to your confirmation teacher if the task is not on the list. It may considered for a worship service project.
