



2024-2025 Confirmation Covenant and Requirements

- **35 Worship Services.** A minimum of **35 services** must be attended from September to September of the following year. If your family goes to funerals, weddings, other churches and Lent services, they will be counted in the total. (Any worships or ceremonies you attend outside of St. John's must be documented by a bulletin signed by the Pastor. Please write your name on the bulletin also.) *The visiting bulletins need to be brought to Confirmation or given to the office within the month of visiting.* If you don't finish 35 services by September of the following year you will continue until you get 35 and then start the 35 for the next year. **PLEASE DISCUSS WITH YOUR YOUNG ADULT:** *Each student is responsible to sign-in on the clip board at the back of church (otherwise they won't get credit for what they have attended.)*
- **20 Worship Notes** – Each student will be required to fill out 20 worship notes per year on a form provided. Each worship note will need to be filled out and turned in right after the service for which the note was taken. If a student chooses to fill out or post more than 20, they will then receive a 1/2 point worship service credit. For Example: if you did an extra 20 worship notes you would receive credit for 10 worship services.
- **15 Worship Service Projects** per Year. There are many available, here is a short list. Acolyte, man the camera for recording worship, read lessons at church services, usher, serve communion, help teach Sunday school and so many other things! These service projects can be done and counted as part of your attending worship requirement. If you need more ideas, contact the church office. Only one worship service project counts per worship service.
- **5 Service Projects** per Year. These can include some of the other things that happen at church such as fall supper preparation, fall supper serving, holiday meal serving, cleaning up the ditch, helping do random projects around the church, or other projects you may do with your family or other groups during the year.
- **3 Bible Verses** – Select three bible verses that will help in your life when times get tough to help you know that God is there for you. Please use the indexes in the back of the Bible to find some. (Look under different things like hope, comfort, anger, etc.)
- **Attendance** – Wednesday evening classes are mandatory (**including worship services during Lent**). You have a maximum 3 excused absences allowed. To be excused you must contact the church office by 4 PM on the Tuesday prior to notify that you will not be attending. Cellphone policy will be strictly enforced.
